Application for Admission

Your application packet must include all required documents. Our Admissions Director will contact you to schedule interviews with members of the Admissions Committee once your application materials have been received.

Applicants who meet the admissions requirements for the Doctor of Acupuncture and Chinese Medicine (DACM) program are encouraged to dually enroll in the MAOM/DACM. Applicants who do not qualify for the DACM or who choose not to dually enroll may enroll in the Master of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (MAOM) program only.

MAOM students have a limited time to apply to the DACM and must apply in specified admissions cycles between the first and second years of the MAOM program. After that time, students must graduate from the MAOM program before applying to the DACM completion track. Academic standing, disciplinary actions, and professionalism issues will be considered for applicants who do not enroll in the DACM from the beginning of their MAOM studies. See Catalog for details.

 - Completion of College level Examination Placement (CLEP) or American Council on Education (ACE) credit
