#### **Application Checklist**

- 1. Application for admission with \$100.00 non-refundable application fee
- 2. 700-1000 words essay answering the following questions: Daoist Traditions is committed to providing the community with Chinese medical care and to graduating practitioners to be the next generation of leaders in the profession. Please tell us about your current practice of Chinese medicine. How do you see a doctoral education in Chinese Medicine impacting your individual practice, your collaboration with other Chinese medicine and Biomedicine practitioners, and your role in advancing the overall profession? Essays evaluated based on content and standard writing conventions.
- 3. Copy of valid driver's license or other government issued photo identification.
- 4. Current 2x2 passport photo (please do not use photo of your actual passport).
- 5. Official college transcripts showing a minimum of three years and 90 semester credits (135 quarter units) of general education at the baccalaureate level from an institution accredited by an agency recognized by the U.S. Secretary of Education, or an equivalent international entity. Sent directly to Daoist Traditions from the institution.
- 6. Documentation of completion of chemistry, biology, and psychology to ensure readiness for doctoral-level coursework. Biology and Psychology – Met by one of the following: 1) Completion of courses in undergraduate education. Transcripts must be sent directly to Daoist Traditions from the institution; 2) Completion of College-level Examination Placement (CLEP) or American Council on Education (ACE) credit courses with the minimum credit-granting scores achieved. Scores must be sent directly to Daoist Traditions from the College Board; or 3) Completion of the following professional-level certificate courses via <u>coursera.org</u>: The Little Stuff - Energy, Cells and Genetics (University of Colorado Boulder); and Introduction to Psychology (Yale University). Certificates of completion/transcripts must be forwarded to Daoist Traditions.

Chemistry - Met by one of the following: 1) Completion of courses in undergraduate education. Transcripts must be sent directly to Daoist Traditions from the institution; 2) Completion of College-level Examination Placement (CLEP) or American Council on Education (ACE) credit courses with the minimum credit-granting scores achieved. Scores must be sent directly to Daoist Traditions from the College Board; 3) Completion of the following professional-level certificate course via coursera.org. Introduction to Chemistry: Reactions and Ratios (Duke University). Certificate of completion/transcript must be forwarded to Daoist Traditions; or 4) Completion of Daoist Traditions asynchronous online course. Must be completed during semester 1 (summer).

- 7. Current curriculum vitae (CV).
- 8. Letter of reference from a person with whom you have a professional relationship, i.e. employer/teacher addressing your ability to be effective in a professional setting, commitment to personal endeavors, integrity, maturity level, and healing presence. Sent directly to Daoist Traditions from the reference.
- 9. Photocopy of current acupuncture license or NCCAOM certification (if completed).
- 10. Graduates from other master's level programs: Official transcripts showing satisfactory completion of an ACAHM accredited/pre-accredited program. DAHM applicants must have completed a master's level acupuncture and Chinese herbal medicine program, [or acupuncture program and Chinese Herbal Medicine Certificate program]. DAc applicants must have completed a master's level acupuncture program no herbal education required for the DAc program. Transcripts must be sent directly to Daoist Traditions from the institution.

#### **Additional Admissions Information**

The admissions process includes a comprehensive analysis of master's level transcripts to ensure that applicable coursework is equivalent to the published Daoist Traditions master's degree program content knowledge and competencies.

Upon acceptance, applicants from other master's level programs must:

- 1) complete a written assessment to confirm masters level content knowledge;
- 2) review a series of videos and complete online assessments on the acupuncture channel systems; and
- 3) review a video and complete an online assessment on research basics, if a college-level research class was not previously completed.

Daoist Traditions alumni who graduated from the master's program more than 5 years prior to entering the doctoral program must complete a written assessment to demonstrate retention of content knowledge and professional competencies.
